## 5.0 Entries

- 5.1 All Masters Competitors must be a registered member of a swimming club (FINA rules) and, with the exception of X and Y categories, be 25 years or over on 31 December 2019. Entries are open and all Masters are welcome.
- 5.2 All events will be Heat Declared Winners in Age Classification. In each event swimmers will be seeded according to their entry time and will compete against those with similar times from the various groups.
- 5.3 All events are swum on a mixed basis.
- 5.4 Dependent on the number of entries received, the organisers reserve the right to: introduce over the top starts, adjust the start time of the sessions.

SWIMMERS WILL BE NOTIFIED OF ANY SUCH ADJUSTMENTS

- 5.5 The 100m Individual Medley will be **FREE** to enter. The top 6 men and top 6 women, in this event, will qualify for the "Graham Pearson" Mixed Up Medley final.
- 5.6 Poolside entries may be available at a cost of £5.00 per event depending on lane availability. This is on the basis of time/records only and no medals or points will be awarded.

Information will be available at the registration/information desk.

- 5.7 Swimmers who do not possess an e-mail address and who require confirmation of the receipt of their entry form must enclose a stamped addressed envelope.

## 6.0 Entry Fees

£7 for 800m Freestyle

£7 for 400 Individual Medley

£5 per event for 50m, 100m and 200m

Those entering more than 6 events on the Saturday will pay a maximum of £30.00

## **7.0 Mixed Up Medley Final 100m**

- 7.1 The fastest 6 men and 6 women in the 100 IM will be invited to take part in the “Mixed up Medley” Final.
- 7.2 The names of the fastest six swimmers, and two reserves, from the heats will be announced as soon as possible after the completion of the 100 IM heats. Qualifying swimmers not intending to compete in the “Mixed up Medley” competition must advise the desk immediately after the announcements so that substitutions can be made.
- 7.3 Before the start of the final the swimmers will be invited to draw a card to identify the lane that they will swim in.
- 7.4 No 2 lanes will swim the strokes in the same order.
- 7.5 No lane will start with backstroke.
- 7.6 No lane will end with backstroke
- 7.7 Every 25m must be swum and completed following the ASA Technical rules for that stroke.
- 7.8 There will be a cash prize for this event the prizes will be: 1<sup>st</sup> £25, 2<sup>nd</sup> £20, 3<sup>rd</sup> £15, 4<sup>th</sup> £10, 5<sup>th</sup> £5 & 6<sup>th</sup> £5

## 17.0 Directions

### Address of Venue:

The Pools, James Street, Carlisle, Cumbria, CA2 5AZ

#### 17.1 From the North - A7 and M6 Junction 44

At Junction 44 take the A7 towards Carlisle city centre along Kingstown Road and then Scotland Road. After crossing over Eden Bridge you will approach a large roundabout (Hardwicke Circus). Stay in centre lane of three lanes.

Take the third exit onto Georgian Way and stay in the right hand lane.

At the lights continue straight ahead onto Spencer Street and stay in the right hand lane.

Continue through the next set of traffic lights but turn right at the second set onto Warwick Road and take up position in the left hand lane.

As you approach the traffic lights at the top of Warwick Road, the left hand lane splits into two with both going to the left onto The Crescent. Take the right hand part of this split going round The Crescent.

As you approach the next set of traffic lights you should have the train station in front of you and the Citadel to your right.

Turn right through the Citadel onto English Street and take up position in the left hand lane. At the next set of traffic lights turn left onto Victoria Viaduct and stay in the left hand lane.

After going over the railway bridge you will approach another set of traffic lights where you turn left onto James Street.

The Pools are now on your left.

Stay in the left hand lane and go past The Pools, Staples and Matalan to a small roundabout and take the first turn off to the left.

Continue along this road, which takes you to the car park at the back of The Pools.

#### 17.2 From the East - A69 and M6 Junction 43

At Junction 43 take the A69 towards Carlisle city centre along Warwick Road.

As you approach the traffic lights at the top of Warwick Road, the left hand lane splits into two with both going to the left onto The Crescent. Take the right hand part of this split going round The Crescent.

As you approach the next set of traffic lights you should have the train station in front of you and the Citadel to your right.

Turn right through the Citadel onto English Street and take up position in the left hand lane. At the next set of traffic lights turn left onto Victoria Viaduct and stay in the left hand lane.

After going over the railway bridge you will approach another set of traffic lights where you turn left onto James Street.

The Pools are now on your left.

Stay in the left hand lane and go past The Pools, Staples and Matalan to a small roundabout and take the first turn off to the left.

Continue along this road, which takes you to the car park at the back of The Pools.

#### 17.3 From the South - A6 and M6 Junction 42

At Junction 42 take the A6 towards Carlisle city centre along London Road and then Botchergate.

As you approach the traffic lights at the top of Warwick Road, the left hand lane splits into two with both going to the left onto The Crescent. Take the right hand part of this split going round The Crescent.

As you approach the next set of traffic lights you should have the train station in front of you and the Citadel to your right.

Turn right through the Citadel onto English Street and take up position in the left hand lane. At the next set of traffic lights turn left onto Victoria Viaduct and stay in the left hand lane.

After going over the railway bridge you will approach another set of traffic lights where you turn left onto James Street.

The Pools are now on your left.

Stay in the left hand lane and go past The Pools, Staples and Matalan to a small roundabout and take the first turn off to the left.

Continue along this road, which takes you to the car park at the back of The Pools.

#### 17.4 By Train.

Take lift from on Platform 4 or between Platforms 1 and 3 to the subway. Follow the subway to the car park, walk through the car park exit where you will see the pool in front of you.
